Winter youth rally:

A great way to start the youth camping year, this meet is held at the scout camp so there are toilet and shower facilities and all meals are included in the cost, the cost will be £15/youth.

The site opens at 4.30pm on Friday, so get dropped off nice and early then get your tent pitched and store all your gear in it. Don't forget to bring plenty of bedding, there could be more snow to come!



When you head over to the building take a pair of indoor shoes that you should keep over there, as we have to keep the building clean and tidy. Outdoor shoes should not be worn in the building.

SUMMER REGION YOUTH RALLY

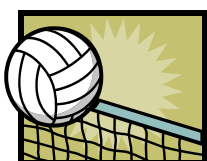
May 11th – 13th Autherthaws Farm, Aughton, Selby. YO42 4PW

The 46th National Youth Rally is being hosted by the Southern region and takes place 6th -8th July, at Ufton Green, Royal County of Berkshire.

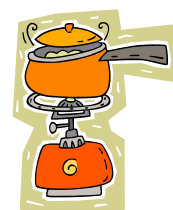
